- Helps manage directory structure for the purpose of keeping the internal systems operations available.
- Operates antivirus solution for the purpose of maintaining an uncompromised computer and network systems.
- Provides technical support of web servers for the purpose of presenting web-based content to internal and external users.
- Reports server status for the purpose of keeping the Information Systems staff abreast of any problems and/or solutions.
- Supports staff and end-users for the purpose of enabling efficient and proper use of servers and server functions.
- Trains staff on server usage for the purpose of being able to utilize any new functionality.
- Assists in the configuration of network devices for the purpose of installing, upgrading, or replacing devices such as switches and access points and phones.
- Travels to various locations throughout Tulare County using own vehicle for the purpose of providing technical and network support.

Skills, Knowledge and/or Abilities:

- maintain and foster a team spirit with fellow staff;
- assist with the operation of a cohesive server farm and maintain its optimum efficiency
- assist with projects and help facilitate their completion
- under the guidance of the System Analyst, build, configure new and/or existing servers
- under the guidance of the Network Analyst, implement, configure and/or install network devices
- assist in the troubleshooting process of data and network equipment
- assist in the diagnoses of data and network equipment

- E-mail systems (internal, external and protection appliances);
- Internet support systems (DNS, IIS, ISA, etc.);
- Internet and server security methodology (Firewalls, DMZ, etc.);
- Familiarity with virtual servers (VMware vSphere, vCenter, ESX, ESXi, etc.)
- Basic switch and router functionally
- Basic VOIP phone installation and configuration
- Basic understanding of wireless networks

Ability to:

- communicate effectively over the phone, in meetings, in seminar settings, or other electronic methods;
- establish and maintain effective working relationships with those contacted during work duties;
- introduce and train others on server technologies and/or network technologies;
- work productively in a multitasking environment; maintain multiple servers and/or network devices;
- setup and configure servers and workstations in a networked environment;
- maintain records and keep documentation up-to-date;

Responsibilities include:

Working under limited supervision following standardized practices and/or methods; providing information and/or advising others; and operating within a defined budget. Utilization of significant resources from other work units is routinely required to perform the job's functions. There is a continual opportunity to impact the organization's services. The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: occasional lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; and some fine finger dexterity. Generally the job requires 70% sitting, 10% walking, and 20% standing. This job is performed in a generally clean and healthy environment.
