Tulare County Office of Education Announces: Child Abuse & Neglect (C.A.N.) Program in Need of Volunteers

The Child Abuse & Neglect (C.A.N.) Prevention Program is seeking volunteers. Sponsored by Tulare County Office of Education, C.A.N. is a preventive program designed to help reduce the incidence of neglect, as well as physical, emotional, and sexual abuse. Serving two to four hours per month, volunteers will work in teams of two and speak from a prepared informational script to kindergarten and fifth-grade classes throughout Tulare County.
