## **Tulare County History Day 2007**

Saturday, March 17, 2007 Sundale Union Elementary, 13990 Ave. 240, Tulare

The public is invited to attend the annual Tulare County History Day event scheduled for Saturday, March 17, 2007, from 8:45 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at Sundale Union Elementary School in Tulare. The year's theme is "Triumph and Tragedy in History."

Tulare County History Day culminates a year-long education program of historical issues, ideas, people and events where students apply what they learn about an historic topic by creating an original presentation. Students may choose any topic in local, national, or world history to research and explore its historical significance in relation to the year's theme.

Students compete in three grade categories: 4-5, 6-8 and 9-12. Students in grades 4-5 compete in the poster category only. Those in the two upper-grade spans analyze their findings and then present them through one of the following categories: historical paper, exhibit, performance, documentary or historical web site. Except for the paper category, students may collaborate in groups of up to five students, or they may work individually. At the event, their presentations

are evaluated by local historians and educators who look for a balance of perspectives in the

project and the types of research evidenced in the bibliography.
