## **SEE Youth Program to Hold Job Fair for Adults**

**Thursday, April 12, 2007 • 2:30 - 6:00 p.m. • 626 North Akers Avenue, Visalia**

The Services for Education & Employment Program (SEE) will conduct a job fair for adults at their offices in Visalia on April 12, 2007. One of the primary employers scheduled to attend the fair is the Delaware North Companies – the concessionary services provider for the national parks, which locally includes Yosemite and Sequoia National Parks. A human resources representative from the company will conduct interviews for temporary summer positions in food service, guest accommodations and maintenance. Applicants must be 18 years old prior to beginning work at the national parks and may be eligible for special room and board incentives, if selected to fill a position. Other employers scheduled to attend the job fair include the U.S. Army, the California Conservation Corps and the National Guard. All adults, 18 and older, are welcome and encouraged to attend the job fair.

SEE Youth Program staff will also be enrolling young people – ages 16 – 21 – in their Youth Employment Program. Applicants do not have to be enrolled in school to qualify. The program provides career guidance, vocational counseling, job placement, follow-up services and

educational tutoring, when necessary. The program is funded by the Tulare County Workforce Investment Board to assist young, low-income Tulare County residents find employment.

“For older high school students and those in college, this event is an ideal place to get information on summer employment,” says Tulare County Superintendent of Schools Jim Vidak.
