## **Fifth annual *Battle of the Books* competition May 7 & 14**

**Elementary: Wednesday, May 14, 8:30 a.m. – 1:15 p.m.**

*Visalia* – Tulare County middle and elementary school teams are scheduled to compete in the annual *Battle of the Books* event May 7 and 14. The **middle school competition** (open to students in grades 6-8) is scheduled for **Thursday, May 7** and has a total of 23 teams participating. The **upper elementary school competition** (open to students in grades 4-6) is scheduled for **Thursday, May 14** and has a total of 32 teams participating.

Students in each competition category prepare months ahead by reading from the same core list of 30 book titles, which they obtained from the program developer, America's Battle of the Books. The book title list was made available to students last summer. At the event, participants compete in teams of six, testing their knowledge of the books in several game show-style events, including Friendly Family Feud, Whiz Kids and Super Challenge. The final event, the Grand Battle Relay, brings all teams together.
