Visalia – The public is invited to see one last public show at the current planetarium facility. The planetarium will relocate to a new building located at 11535 Avenue 264 this fall.

May 8, 7:00 p.m. – *Earth, Moon and Sun*

How do the Earth, Moon and Sun work together as a system and what is the myth and science behind it? Why does the Sun rise and set? Why do we see different constellations during different seasons? What is an eclipse? Learn about the Moon's phases and orbit. Explore past and future space travel to our moon and beyond.
