300 Dinuba after school students registered to participate in MyPlate Color Run, May 4, 2017

The Tulare County Office of Education's CHOICES After School Program and Nutrition Education Obesity Prevention Program, in partnership with the Dinuba Unified School District, the California Department of Public Health's Champions for Change program, the University of California Cooperative Extension and its CalFresh Nutrition Education program, the Alta Family Health Clinic, Kaweah Delta Health Care District, and FoodLink for Tulare County, have organized a healthy activities event for Thursday evening at Kennedy Elementary School in Dinuba. Limited to members of the Dinuba CHOICES After School Program, over 300 children and family members have registered to attend the first MyPlate Color Run.
