2018 Tulare County College Night at International Agri-Center, Tulare 5:30 – 8:00 p.m. • Tuesday, September 11, 2018 International Agri-Center, Building C, 4500 S. Laspina, Tulare

The Tulare County Office of Education's annual College Night will be held on September 11 **at a new location – the International Agri-Center in Tulare**. Representatives from nearly 80 colleges, universities and technical schools will be in attendance to answer questions about entrance requirements, tuition and housing at their institutions. In addition, the US Army and the National Guard will have representatives at the event. Open to the public at 5:30 p.m., Tulare County College Night is designed for high school students and parents who want to learn more about preparing for and applying to colleges.

In addition to the college representatives, students and parents can visit five informational presentations (beginning at 6:30 and 7:30 p.m.) on topics that include financial aid, SAT/ACT test preparation, and registration information for the University of California and California State University systems. One presentation on financial aid and another on planning for college will be offered in Spanish.
