Performing Troupe

The Theatre Company is seeking students interested in auditioning for its performing troupe. Auditions will be held Monday, December 10, at 3:30 in the Elderwood room at the Office of Education's Doe Avenue Complex in Visalia. Ten to twenty-five students from throughout Tulare County will be chosen to represent the Theatre Company at various community and statewide events. Students selected for the troupe should be prepared to make a one-semester commitment. Rehearsal for the troupe is tentatively scheduled for Tuesdays from 6:30-8:30 pm, depending on the schedules of the students selected.

Students, grades 1 – 12, who want to be considered for the Performing Troupe, should prepare a piece of music for a vocal audition. Students are encouraged to wear dance or athletic shoes and comfortable clothing. Please contact the Theatre Company at 651-1482 before the audition for sheet music, as an accompanist will be provided. As an option, students may bring their own sheet music.
