Registration is now open for TCOE's annual College Night. This year, the event will be virtual with representatives from nearly 60 colleges and universities available. Students may meet with representatives of their choice, but are encouraged to have questions prepared for their virtual visits.

“Based on our success with virtual teacher recruitment fairs which simulate the look of a convention center-style event, we utilized the same technology to make College Night virtual,” said Tim Hire, Tulare County Superintendent of Schools. “Students and parents will enter the event through a grand lobby before discovering the booths of the representatives in the Exhibit Hall.”
