Jeff Ramsay asked the Board's approval on Resolution No. 23/24-02 to apply for a grant application for a new alternative fuel vehicle grant for five electric vehicles. Mr. Enea mentioned that he heard there is going to be a jump in insurance cost for electric vehicles. Jeff said that TCOE is going to lease the vehicles by contracting with a 5-year lease cycle. Once the vehicle lease ends, Enterprise will sell them. Every leased term, we will replace the fleet vehicles. Our efficiency is great for in-town travel. We may only end up having to buy a set of tires during their life span. In the resolution it says leasing is permitted. The resolution also authorizes Jeff Ramsay as an administrator for this grant. It was moved by Maldonado-Arroyo, seconded by Coble to approve Resolution No. 23/24-02. Motion unanimously carried with the following votes: Ayes: Coble, Enea, Holguin, Link, Maldonado-Arroyo, Reed, and Rodriguez.

SUPERINTENDENT'S
REPORT

Superintendent Tim Hire called on Julie Berk. She introduced the new CHOICES Administrator, Bob Mayo. Frank Silveira chose to be the new administrator for School Safety Programs and ActVnet. Mr. Hire went on to announce that Chris Meyer was selected as the new Assistant Superintendent for District Support Services.

Tim thanked the Board for attending the 2023 Convocation. He received several compliments, especially on the keynote speaker, Elizabeth Huntley. There were departments who wore matching shirts to be identified as a unit. We had 1,418 staff members who registered this year. Mr. Hire wants people to work out of commitment and not out of compliance. This year there were over 160 employees that walked across the stage for their years of service at TCOE. This year's convocation included "impact stories". Next year the goal is to highlight staff modeling our core values.

Tuesday, September 12, is College Night at the Visalia Convention Center.

Mr. Enea said COS is opening their University Center. He wants to see economic growth to keep people here. Mrs. Maldonado-Arroyo said that she feels we do not attract companies that hire and pay comparable wages.

The water quality situation in Springville has not affected SCICON.

Tom Link advised the Board that he had a zoom meeting on August 1 with Heather Rubio from our auditor's office. He gave praise to Jody Arriaga and her staff for the remarkable work they do for our business office.

2. The Tulare County Board of Education (Board), in order to comply with the requirements of Education Code 60119, held a public hearing on September 13, 2023, at 4:30 p.m., which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that pupils attend school and the end of the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;
3. The Board provided at least 10 days' notice of the public hearing by posting it in at least three public places within the county stating the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;
4. The Board encouraged participation by parents/guardians, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders in the public hearing, and;

The definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each student, including each English learners, has a standards-aligned textbook or instructional materials to use in class and to take home, which may include materials in a digital format but shall not include photocopied sheets from only a portion of a textbook or instructional materials copied to address a shortage, and;
7. Textbooks or instructional materials in core curriculum subjects should be aligned with state academic content standards and/or Common Core State Standards adopted by the State Board of Education.
