

Keynote Speaker



Dr. Robert A. Flores Cal Poly

Dr. Flores joined the Agricultural Education & Communication Department in 1983. He was a professor and department head and currently serves as Professor Emeritus. He still

serves as Professor Emeritus. He still teaches graduate courses for the master's program and also serves as a core faculty member for the California Agricultural Leadership Program.

Dr. Flores attended Bakersfield College for one year before transferring to Cal Poly, where he received a degree in Animal Science. He completed student teaching at Hanford High School, followed by five years of teaching at San Benito High School in Hollister. He earned a Ph.D. in Agricultural Education from Texas A&M University. Dr. Flores worked in Costa Rica in the development of EARTH University (Escuela de Agricultura de la Región Tropical Húmeda).

Dr. Flores served as a co-advisor to the Cal Poly Latinos in Agriculture, and he served as a national officer of the Minorities in Agriculture, Natural Resources and Related Sciences (MANRRS).
