ELIGIBILITY:

Eligibility is limited to individuals. No team entries are allowed.

EXPECTATIONS:

Participants are expected to have knowledge of Automotive systems and parts, and a willingness to learn about newer technologies.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

Participants will be given opportunities to learn about newer technologies in equipment and diagnostic practices. They will then be challenged to answer questions in relation to what they have learned.
