ELIGIBILITY:

Open to teams and solo videographers.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

- A list of competition elements must be included in each submission. This is to ensure older work or work created for other competitions isn't used in this competition.
- Creative application of competition elements is encouraged.
 1. Required Line – The required line of dialogue must be heard OR seen – it may be written. It may be in a foreign language; however, if it is not clear that this is the required line, it must be translated.
 2. Required Theme– The must be evident within your body of work. Points will be deducted if the theme isn't readily noticeable.
 3. Required Shot – This year we will be incorporating a cinematography challenge and asking students to complete a specific shot outlined within the Prompts page. This is intended to teach and stretch the students.
- Teams shall develop an original video utilizing all competition elements.
- Entries should be fictional in nature, however must be presented in a category such as a PSA, documentary, comedy sketch, or short film.
- Entries should be approximately 2-8 minutes long, and should not exceed 8 minutes (closing credits do not count towards time limit).
- Videos may NOT contain copyrighted images or music without written permission.
- All videos must include a Black title card at the beginning of the film that includes; Title, instructor name, students names, & category (see above).
- Students must complete the attached form for entry submission.

All entries must be submitted by 11:59pm March 30th, 2025 to the link provided (<https://shorturl.at/Ok8RV>).

- Videos must be submitted in .mp4 OR .MOV format.
- Please make sure your video file is labeled as such SCHOOL_TEAM

- Videos will be screened live but will be judged prior to live viewing.

2024 EXPO Video Prompts

1. Cinematography Challenge: WHIP PAN

Please include at least 1 Whip Pan in your film. A Whip Pan is a fast lateral pan of the camera often spanning a large distance between two objects in the same focal plane. The idea is to focus on one object and pan quick to create a blur and end on your second object therefore connecting two locations in the same space. Additionally a Whip Pan can be used to convey speed. These shots are often in the same space but following the speed of an object as it travels. We've included two examples below.
