

Methodologies to add a Single Subject Teaching Credential



If you hold a valid

Clear

teaching credential (multiple or single)

If you currently hold a clear credential, and wish to add a new single subject credential or an additional content area to your existing single subject credential, you must meet requirements 1-4 below:

If you hold a valid

Preliminary

teaching credential (multiple or single)

If you currently hold a preliminary credential and wish to add a new single subject credential or an additional content area to your existing single subject credential, you must meet requirements 1-4, plus 5 and 6 below:

- Meet content area subject-matter competency (via degree, CSET, or subject matter review)
- Complete Methodologies course (EDU406 with IMPACT program)
- Possess an English learner authorization issued by the Commission authorizing service in English Language Development (ELD) and Specially Designed Academic Instruction delivered in English (SDAIE)
- Complete CTC application and processing fee through NTLD

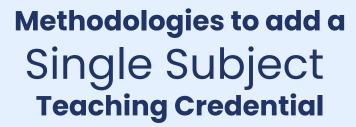
- Coursework in developing English language skills, including reading (unless this requirement was previously satisfied for another teaching credential issued by the Commission)
- Demonstration of a knowledge of the principles and provisions of the Constitution of the United States by coursework (two semester units or three quarter units) or examination (unless this requirement was previously satisfied for another teaching credential issued by the Commission)

- Program Intent Form
- \$250 Application Fee
- · Copy of current CTC teaching credential
- Verification of subject matter for new credential

Step 3: Begin coursework

- EDU406 Single Subject Methodologies
 - o 15 sessions total
 - 8 virtual class sessions via Zoom
 - 7 in-person sessions at TCOE
 - Runs October February (for the 2025-26 school year)

Step 4: Credential Application

Candidate requests transcripts from NTLD and submits their credential application directly to CTC
