INTERVENTION RESOURCE CLASSROOMS

In partnership with local school districts, the Intervention Resource Classrooms (IRC) create a comprehensive educational and therapeutic addition. With a focus on the social emotional wellness of our students, Intervention Resource Classrooms core component is teaching students the skills necessary for educational success. Skill-building is taught using evidence-based social skills curriculum in conjunction with individualized therapeutic services.

ACADEMIC COLLABORATIVE FOR EXCEPTIONAL LEARNERS (ACCEL)

Educational programs for students with moderate to severe intellectual disabilities focus on life skills, academics, language development, vocational training, and leisure skills. Students who are educated in one of the TCOE-operated special centers generally have multiple or profound disabilities, and/or are able to function best in a more sheltered environment.

MILD / MODERATE PROGRAM

The Mild/Moderate Program provides instructional support services to students with mild to moderate disabilities. The Tulare County Office of Education provides these services to the 26 small, direct-service school districts in Tulare County, along with two TCOE charter schools and the county's court/community school sites. These instructional services are designed to support students with disabilities who are having difficulty with the general education curriculum in the areas of reading, writing, and mathematics.
