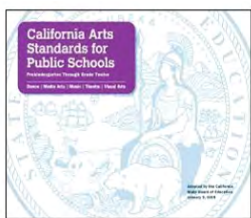

About the Arts Standards

Adopted in 2019, California's PK-12th grade arts standards encompass the arts disciplines of dance, media arts, music, theatre and visual arts. The standards feature four artistic processes and 11 anchor standards threaded across all five arts disciplines. They are inquiry-based and emphasize the process of artistic creation as a key component. Based on the National Core Arts Standards and aligned to both ELA and math, the arts standards provide limitless opportunities for interdisciplinary connections.
