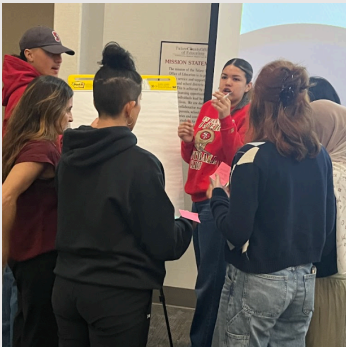

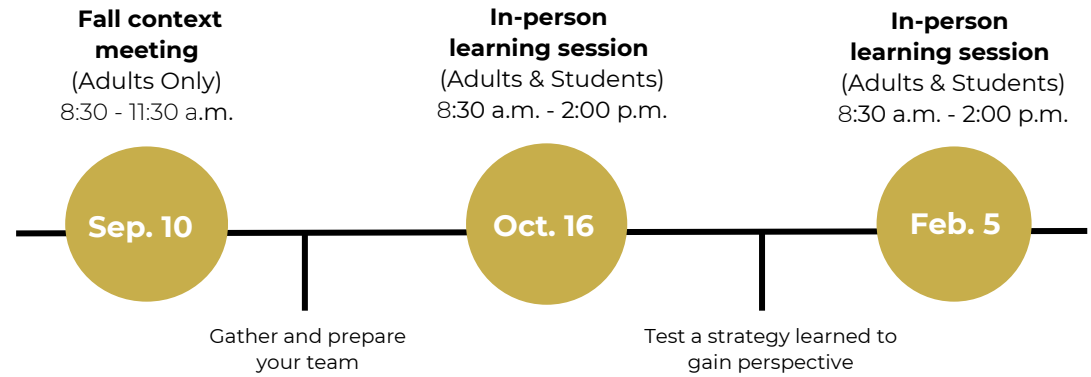

Youth-Adult Equity

Looking for ways to enhance your student engagement?

What is Youth-Adult Equity? We often make decisions about schools without true input from those we are serving: students, families, and communities. Additionally, we often over rely on input gathered from surveys. Let's move beyond the survey together.

We're holding a half-day session on September 10 for adults to discuss a new training event which will bring students and adults together to address issues effecting school climate. Adult leaders will attend the half-day session on September 10 to learn how to prepare and build their team to participate. The full-day events for **student and adult** teams will be held on October 16, 2024 and February 5, 2025. Adult leaders will be required to attend all three sessions.
