Join us for a focused, one-day workshop that will equip education leaders with the knowledge and tools to implement and scale High Impact Tutoring (HIT) in their districts. Grounded in evidence-based practices, HIT is a targeted intervention designed to accelerate student learning through frequent, relationship-based, data-informed instruction aligned to grade-level content outside of core instruction.

Participants will explore components from Stanford University's HIT Sprint Action Plan, examine key design principles that distinguish HIT from traditional tutoring, and engage in collaborative planning to identify actionable next steps for site and district implementation. This session is ideal for instructional coaches, site administrators, and district leaders seeking to close opportunity gaps and strengthen student outcomes with strategic, high-leverage support.
