Making Sense of the CDE Literacy Blocks Grades 6-12

This professional learning session is designed for grades 6-12 teachers and will provide clarity and guidance around the California Literacy Content Blocks. Participants will learn that the literacy blocks are not a new initiative, but rather a consolidation of the California ELA/ELD Framework into a clear, actionable structure for daily instruction. The session will highlight how the literacy blocks organize and elevate existing evidence-based practices across Language, Foundational Literacy Skills, Integrated Reading and Writing, and Comprehensive ELD. Teachers will engage in practical examples that demonstrate how current instructional practices can be aligned to and integrated within the literacy blocks, supporting coherent, standards-aligned implementation of the framework in classrooms.
