Building a Responsive Teaching Toolkit to accelerate learning for all students

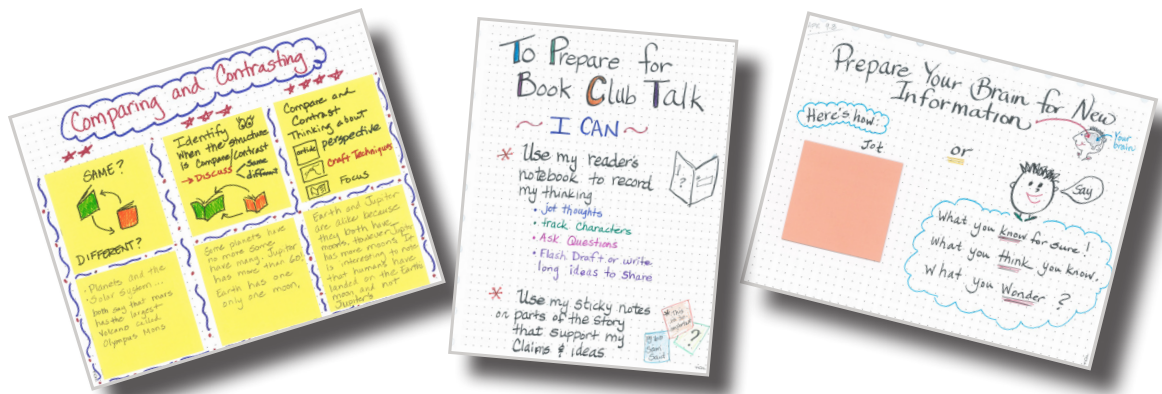
Grades K-12

Teachers need resources readily available to assist students in building independence as readers, writers, and speakers. Sometimes it's a simple anchor chart or strategy chart. Students may need a demonstration that aligns with success criteria – a bookmark tool to recall a process or learning progressions to help them accelerate toward learning goals.

Outcomes:

This course will provide participants with:

- A collection of resources for immediate use when working strategically with readers, writers, and speakers
- Resources applicable to multiple instructional settings: 1:1 conferencing, small groups, strategy groups, book clubs, cross-content literacy, supporting English language development, and in workshop settings as mini-lesson tools
- An individual resource notebook of tools for delivering strategic instruction, conferring, and providing students with support that builds skill and independence
