Civic Engagement Grades TK-12

In order for students to experience that they belong to a local, national, and global community, they must have the opportunity to increase their civic knowledge and skills. Students need to be equipped to connect and apply their learning using complex cognitive skills, while engaging in civic actions using democratic means. Engaged citizens are informed, participate in civil discourse, make claims supported by evidence, and address political and public policies. These engaged citizens are first formed as engaged students supported by their TK- 12 education. Students can earn the State Seal of Civic Engagement in the 11th and 12th grade and now they, their classes, and their schools can earn Civic Engagement Learning certificates from Tulare County Office of Education for their work in their grade-level band. Participants will gain lessons, resources, and instructional strategies as well as time and support for planning implementation and connection of civic engagement to their core curriculum.
