Disciplinary Literacy

Grades 6-12

This professional learning session for 6-12 teachers will explore reading, writing, and thinking strategies not just for English language arts, but also for science and history-social science, emphasizing the concept that language and literacy instruction is a shared responsibility across all grade spans and content areas.

Disciplinary literacy empowers students to read, write, and think like experts, whether they are exploring classic novels and thought-provoking expository texts in English language arts; empirical research and informative articles in science; or landmark primary source documents and famous speeches in history-social science.

Teachers will leave this session with strategies and routines to help students analyze texts across the disciplines, as well as craft their own oral and written evidence-based arguments with academic language support.

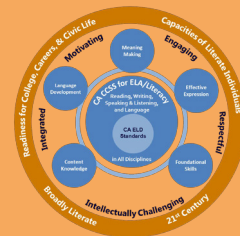
