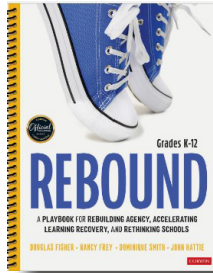
## Welcomes Dr. Nancy Frey!

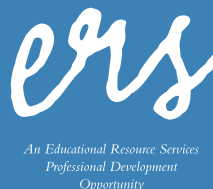
