How do you support student thinking and engagement?

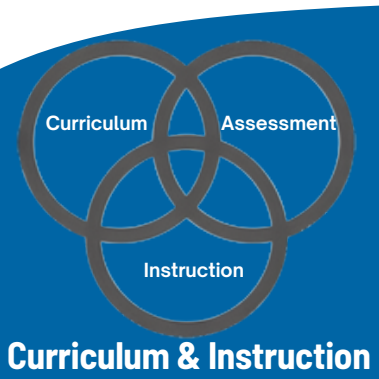
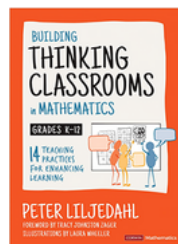
Learn how to transform your classroom into an ideal setting for deep student thinking and accelerated learning! Through Building Thinking Classrooms and the 5 Practices for Orchestrating Discourse, you will engage in practices that create optimal conditions for learning - conditions where students become responsible for doing the thinking.

We will spend the morning learning together, then step into the classroom with students to apply the learning from the morning session. You will engage in real-time learning and application in a learning lab setting. At the end of the day we will reconvene to reflect and workshop.

Goals and Outcomes

You will experience a process that helps you decide:

- What aspects of a task to highlight
- How to organize and connect the work of students and student work
- What questions to ask to challenge student thinking
- How to make students' thinking visible
- How to elevate student voice and promote knowledge mobility
