Together we will:

Session #1 & #2: Understanding CGI's Theory

- Explore the research behind CGI, discuss problem types and solution strategies, and how children develop mathematical thinking.
- Learn how to assess and respond to students' mathematical reasoning.

Session #3 & #4: Integrated CGI Implementation

- Collaborate to design and implement a CGI-aligned lesson with students using multiplication and division problem types.
- Reflect on student thinking and refine instructional approaches based on observations to plan next steps.
