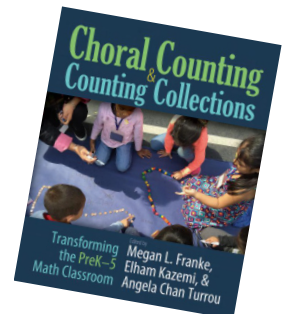
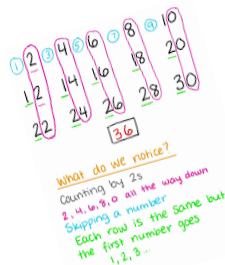

- Choral Counting is a counting routine that supports students in reasoning about number patterns while developing deeper conceptual understanding and fluency with the number system.
- Counting Collections is an engaging student-centered activity where students build their understanding of numbers by counting collections of objects and representing their thinking.
