

Choral Counting & Counting Collections Grades K-2


Join us as we explore two powerful routines that will build student number sense throughout the year. This workshop will provide the opportunity to learn how to implement Choral Counting and Counting Collections during your mathematics instruction for kindergarten through second grade.

- Choral Counting is a counting routine that supports students in reasoning about number patterns while developing deeper conceptual understanding and fluency with the number system.
- Counting Collections is an engaging, student-centered activity where students build their understanding of numbers by counting collections of objects and recording their thinking.
