PRELIMINARY ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REPORT – NO FURTHER ACTION DETERMINATION, TULARE COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION, TCOE FACILITY, 26277 NORTH MOONEY BOULEVARD, VISALIA, TULARE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (PROJECT CODE: 104909)

Dear Mr. Ramsay:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) reviewed the Preliminary Environmental Assessment Report (PEA Report) prepared by Padre Associates, Inc., December 9, 2025, on behalf of the Tulare County Office of Education (TCOE) for the proposed new school to be located on an approximately 18-acre property located at 26277 N. Mooney Boulevard, Visalia, Tulare County, California (Site). The PEA Report includes the results of background information and activities to investigate the Site for potential impacts from chemicals of potential concern (COPC) that may pose a threat to human health or the environment.

On December 1, 2025, the TCOE notified DTSC that it had complied with all public review and comment requirements for the draft PEA Report pursuant to Education Code section 17213.1(a)(6)(A). The TCOE made the PEA Report available for public review and comment from October 15, 2025, through November 14, 2025, and held a public hearing on November 5, 2025. No public comments were received.

Additional assessment, investigation, or cleanup may be required.
