Tulare County Office of Education operates Circle J-Norris Ranch as part of the SCICON program and UC Merced Field Station.

Job Duties:

- Use GPS coordinates to locate, mark, verify, and label study plots on Circle J-Norris Ranch
- Hike on and off trails and roads to set up research plots
- Generate accurate records and troubleshoot problems
- Use equipment and tools in a safe and responsible manner
- Other duties as assigned
- Work 5 hours per day for four days (June 2, 3, 4, 5, 2024)

Minimum Requirements:

- Must have transportation
- High school student or Class of 2025 graduate
- Ability to work effectively in a team
- Ability to hike in rugged conditions in hot weather while carrying heavy equipment
