Joyful Writing in PreK & TK Learning Institute

This three-day institute will offer ways to promote the joy of writing and very early literacy learning with young children in transitional kindergarten. Participants will learn to plan for systematic learning opportunities across the day that harness children's natural playfulness and curiosity, as they build a foundation for listening, speaking, reading, and writing across the day. **Topics include:**

- Contributions of writing to language, literacy, and learning
- Authentic writing and the writing process for young children
- · Early writing and concepts about print
- Supporting phonemic awareness, word study, and phonics through writing
- · Building a community of young writers
- Book-making, interactive writing, and other handson learning across the day



The Joyful Writing Institute is crafted to systematically foster growth and provide support. Participating districts and staff members commit to a year-long instructional cycle, comprising of inperson training, on-site coaching, and a virtual community of practice.
